ToR for a subcontractor for the project Local voices to the global process – "Civil Society shapes the Just Transition"

1 Background/Hintergrund

The projects' global objective is to strengthen the Just Transition Process in four different world regions, which include anchor countries for the German government, so called P+ countries. Just transition is widely defined, as changing to a low-carbon economy, while making sure that descent work, poverty eradication and social inclusion for everyone are integral parts. According to Germanwatch, this can only function well if local civil society can shape and influence the Just Transition process based on their needs and if it creates support especially for vulnerable people to leave no one behind. To properly involve civil society and make their voices heard it is important to ensure early engagement, support a regular and transparent flow of information, incorporate stakeholder feedback and consider differences in access and power. Therefore, we define the specific objective of the project to support the just transition process in the Western Balkans, in Peru, in Indonesia and in India by leveraging the expertise of local civil society networks to inform the international discourse with local knowledge and to create impact on the global political scenery.

2 Purpose, Objectives and Use / Bedarfsbegründung, Ziel und Zweck

We have two partners for the Western Balkans Component: Balkan Green Foundation for Kosovo and Belgrade Open School for Serbia. To address the region as a whole it is necessary to have one more organization that provides knowledge for North Macedonia and the good practices of Just Transition happening in North Macedonia. Like this, we get a better understanding of the region as a whole.

3 Roles/Rollen

Germanwatch coordinates the project and all partners. We compile knowledge and address the advocacy activities in Germany and for the EU. The contractor would gather intelligence from North Macedonia in regard to Just Transition. The contractor coordinates a local core group, in a coal Region; Region of Just Transition.

4 Scope of Work / Leistungsumfang

Responsible to coordinate and implement all national activities happening in North Macedonia in full responsibility. Contributing to the regional activities with local knowledge and expertise, support the Lead organisation in organisational matters.
